WHAT TO DO NEXT?

We can help you talk around the globe using HF, or the Internet linked Digital Mobile Radio (DMR), or D-STAR technologies. Or any of the following:

- **CW (Morse Code)** – Send Morse Code messages around the globe.
- **Digital Mobile Radio (DMR)** – Talk around the world with a \$90 radio.
- **Slow Scan TV (SSTV)** – Send and receive pictures across town, or from the International Space Station.
- **Single Side Band (SSB)** – talk to hams around the world.
- **Amateur Radio Emergency Data Network (AREDN)** – Use high-frequency radios to send and receive data for miles.
- **Build Your Own** – Solder up radio kits, antennas, or computer interfaces.
- **Public Service** – Use your communications skills at marathons, bike races, or other civic events.
- **Local Repeater Contacts** – Use a mobile radio to keep in touch with your local amateur radio friends.
- **Contesting** – Use your radio to enter contests that let you compete with others by making radio contacts.
- **Radio Interfacing** – Use a Raspberry Pi or Arduino computers to connect the world of radio to the Internet.
- **Direction Finding** – Use antennas and skills to locate hidden transmitters.
